TAKE NOTICE: The Financial Services Authority (the "FSA") of 25 The North Colonnade, Canary Wharf, London E14 5HS gives you, Peter Richard Hilder formerly trading as Savings Assured Mortgages, final notice about a decision to cancel the permission granted to you to carry on regulated activities

### 1. ACTION

- 1.1 The FSA gave you a Decision Notice on 27 November 2008 (the "Decision Notice") which notified you that for the reasons given below and pursuant to section 45 of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (the "Act"), the FSA had decided to cancel the permission granted to you pursuant to Part IV of the Act ("your permission").
- 1.2 You were informed of your statutory right to make a reference to the Financial Services and Markets Tribunal, but you have not referred the matter to the Tribunal within 28 days of the date on which the Decision Notice was given to you. Accordingly the FSA has today cancelled your permission.

# 2. REASONS FOR ACTION

- 2.1 By a First Supervisory Notice dated 1 August 2008, your permission was varied by removing all regulated activities with immediate effect and by including a requirement on you to notify all of your clients for regulated activities that you were no longer permitted by the FSA to carry on regulated activities. A copy of the First Supervisory Notice, by which the FSA removed all regulated activities from your permission, is displayed on the FSA's web site.
- 2.2 Sub-section (3) of section 45 of the Act requires that, if, as a result of a variation of a Part IV permission under that section, there are no longer any regulated activities for which the authorised person concerned has permission, the FSA must, once it is satisfied that it is no longer necessary to keep the permission in force, cancel it.
- 2.3 The FSA is so satisfied and accordingly has a duty to cancel your permission.

### 3. DECISION MAKER

The decision which gave rise to the obligation to issue this Final Notice was taken by the Regulatory Decisions Committee.

### 4. IMPORTANT

4.1 This Final Notice is given to you in accordance with section 390(1) of the Act.

## **Publicity**

- 4.2 Sections 391(4), 391(6) and 391(7) of the Act apply to the publication of information about the matter to which this Final Notice relates. Under those provisions, the FSA must publish such information about the matter to which this Final Notice relates as the FSA considers appropriate. The information may be published in such manner as the FSA considers appropriate. However, the FSA may not publish information if such publication would, in the opinion of the FSA, be unfair to you or prejudicial to the interests of consumers.
- 4.3 The FSA intends to publish such information about the matter to which this Final Notice relates as it considers appropriate.
