We have processed your email in line with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and our response is below. Please accept our sincere apologies for delay in responding to you.

We have interpreted 'imposed' to mean where the FCA has taken its own-initiative action under the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 ("FSMA"), rather than by way of either imposing a restriction in response to an application by a firm's own initiative for the imposition, variation or cancellation of a requirement under FSMA; or by way of a court order.

We can disclose that four firms that are authorised to give financial advice, have asset retention requirements imposed on them by the FCA between 1 August 2019 – 1 August 2020.
