Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act), for information relating to E-money Licences/Institutions.

Your request has now been considered and I confirm that we hold information that falls within the scope of your request, as set out below.

1. The number of full e-money licenses issued by the FCA since 2008 to present

There were 112 e-money licences issued by the FCA for the period in question.

2. How many of these authorised e-money institutions have passported into Europe since 2008 ?

Since 2008 the number of authorised e-money firms that passported into Europe is 91.

3. How many foreign authorised e-money institutions have passported into UK since 2008 ?

The number of foreign authorised e-money institutions that have passported in the UK since 2008 is 12.
