Freedom of Information : Right to know request

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act). The information requested follows on from your original request FOI5111.

Your original request (FOI5111) was:

"I would like to know the number (by premium amount or by number of policies) of SIPP and personal pension sales in submissions by FCA regulated firms made to Gabriel in each of the last five years (years ending 31 March) 2016/17, 2015/16, 2014/15, 2013/14, 2012/13.

I would like this data broken down geographical location using whichever breakdown is most commonly used by the FCA e.g. by postcode or by parliamentary constituency or by local authority etc.

If you are only able to give us information on one of these products within the scope of the freedom of information act, the please provide the breakdown for personal pensions."

Your new request (FOI5160) is:

"I just wonder is it possible for you to provide this data by the postcode of where the policy holders live and the monetary value of the policies?"

Before considering your request, it is important to know that the information reported by Gabriel is as follows:

We receive information in relation to SIPP and personal pension transactions, not by the numbers of policies (either new policies or additional contributions to existing policies).

Your request has now been considered and I can confirm the information provided in the tables attached are for the monetary value of the transactions reported. This is separated by postcode and year.

We hold the premium amount of SIPP and personal pension transactions (which you had requested in FOI5111). This information can be found in the attached tables broken down by postcode. Please note that the information has been extrapolated from information provided to the FCA by firms; in some instances this information may not be submitted in a uniform format therefore caution should be exercised before using the information to support any conclusions you may reach.
