- 1. As of today (10 May 2019) how many CF30 customer permission holders were women?
- 2. As of today (10 May 2019) how many CF30 customer permission holders were men?
- 3. As 10 May 2018 how many CF30 customer permission holders were women?
- 4. As 10 May 2018 how many CF30 customer permission holders were men?"

Your request has now been considered, and I can confirm that we hold the information you have requested, as set out below.

- 1. As of today (10 May 2019) 10,823 CF30 customer permission holders were women.
- 2. As of today (10 May 2019) 63,585 CF30 customer permission holders were men.
- 3. As 10 May 2018 10,302 CF30 customer permission holders were women.
- 4. As 10 May 2018 62,500 CF30 customer permission holders were men.

We believe this should satisfy your request, however, if you are unhappy with the decision made in relation to your request, you have the right to request an internal review. If you wish to exercise this right you should contact us within 40 working days of the date of this response.
