Freedom of Information: Right to know request

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the Act") dated 08 July 2019 for the following information:

"With reference to your press release on 19th June 2019, entitled "Defined benefit pension transfers – market-wide data results", we would like to request further details on the figures published.

Firstly, can you confirm that firms were asked only to report members looking to transfer from Defined Benefit schemes and therefore that the survey does not include any schemes moving in entirety, from Defined Benefit to Defined Contribution? If the figures do include whole scheme moves, can you remove them from the following data requests....

Please can you provide a quarterly breakdown of the total number of members that proceeded with a Defined Benefit transfer during the survey period and the total value of proceeding transfers by quarter.

Also, can you confirm on a quarterly basis, the number of members who received advice, but didn't proceed and their total value.

Finally, can you show quarterly, the number of members who were triaged away from the advice process following an initial discussion, captured by your survey, acknowledging that this may have been under reported by some firms."

Based on our response to the above request, you requested the following information on 06 August 2019:

"Given you don't hold quarterly data, would it be possible please to answer my requests, segregating the requested data across the "one 6-month period and three 1-year periods?"

Your request has now been considered, and our response is outlined below.

1. Please can you provide a breakdown of the total number of members that proceeded with a Defined Benefit transfer during the survey period and the total value of proceeding transfers.

The number of clients recommended to transfer and those recommended not to transfer who proceeded as insistent clients was as follows:
