Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act), dated 20 September 2019, concerning Authorised Payment Institutions (APIs) and e-money institutions (EMIs).

On 4 November 2019, further to our request for clarification, you confirmed that you would like "only payment institutions and e-money institutions to be included in the scope [of the request, and for the] answers to each question to be broken down into a) payment institutions and b) e-money institutions".

On this basis, your request has now been considered, and we will respond to each point in turn.

As such the statistics provided above may not represent the totality of such firms under investigation by the FCA.
