## Freedom of Information: Right to know request

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) dated 23 October 2019, for the following information;

"Under the Freedom of Information Act, and following a previous FOI request, reference FOI5142, I would like to have the below functions split by gender where the applicants have stated Mr, Ms, Mrs and Miss in their application.

- 1. How many Control Function 1 Holders are women, how many are men?
- 2. How many Control Function 2 Holders are women, how many are men?
- 3. How many Control Function 3 Holders are women, how many are men?
- 4. How many Control Function 4 Holders are women, how many are men?

Please provide data broken down for each of the last five years with a year-end date of September 30, or whichever year-end date is most convenient. If you cannot provide data for each of the last five years, then please provide data for each of the last three years. If that is not possible, then please provide data for each of the most recent two years."

We have now considered your request and our response is set out in the table below. It outlines the total number of men and women holding CF1, CF2, CF3 and CF4 positions broken down by year end for the last five years.

 There is a drop in the numbers between 2015 and 2016. This is because a number of CF1, CF2 and CF3 function holders at dual regulated firms were converted to SMF and SIMF functions under the SMCR (Senior Managers and Certification Regime) and SIMR (Senior Insurance Management Regime).
