Please note that the information provided is based on firms submitting the Retail Mediation Activities Return (RMAR) rather than on permissions and only reflects the intermediary firms that submit that return.

Reflects a count of reporting firms that were on the FCA Register at the relevant calendar year-end and that reported a Profit and Loss account for a full year.
