Thank you for your email of 8 October 2020 about applications for Senior Management Function roles. Full details of your request can be found in Annex A below.

We are handling your email as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We can disclose some of the information to you set out in the tables in Annex B below.

In reading our response, please be aware we note your comments allowing us to just consider the readily available data during the five year period requested. We have therefore provided data which we have been able to easily extract within the cost limit allowed under FOIA.

Further, the figures provided relate to interviews of individuals applying to hold both Senior Manager Functions under the Senior Management and Certification Regime (SMCR) and Significant Influence Functions under Approved Persons Regime (APER) at authorised firms.

In addition, we would like to explain that in **Table 1** we have presented the available data for the calendar years 2016 to 3 November 2020 (the information for 2015 is not available in a readily extractable format) and this includes the following information:

- The total number of interviews conducted by the FCA, highlighting the number of interviews conducted solely by the FCA and the remainder of these interviews conducted jointly with the Prudential Regulation Authority (PRA) for dual regulated firms.
- Number of FCA lead interviews, these are interviews instigated and conducted by the FCA
 as a sole regulator. So, for Q1 of 2016 there were 32 interviews in total, out of which 18
 were led by the FCA as a sole regulator.

With regards to **Table 2**, this contains a breakdown of interviews by sector conducted during the calendar years 2019 and 2020 to date. The information prior to 2019 is not available in a readily extractable format.
