Thank you for your email of 30 December 2020 about our active investigations.

We are handling your email as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) and will answer each question in turn.

1. The number of active investigations into individuals?

We currently have 368 active investigations into individuals.

2. The number of active investigations into companies?

We currently have 219 active investigations into firms/companies.

3. Breakdown of statistics into whether the individuals are senior managers?

Of the 368 active investigations into individuals, 30 of those investigations are into Senior Managers as defined in the Senior Managers & Certification Regime.
