We have processed your emails as a request for information in line with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) and our response is below.

1. How many firms gave up their DB transfer permissions between September and 31 December 2020.

The total number of firms that gave up their DB transfer permissions between September and 31 December 2020 is 259.

2. How many firms were asked to give up their DB transfer permissions between September and 31 December 2020.

Of the firms that gave up their DB permissions between 1 September 2020 and 31 December 2020, 21 firms were "asked" to give up their permissions.

3. In regard to question 1, please note which firms gave up their permissions entirely, or amended their permissions.

Permission to advise on Defined Benefit (DB) pension transfers can be relinquished by either (a) removing the permission Advising on pension transfers and opt/outs (PTOO) entirely or (b) adding a limitation to the permission to exclude advice on DB pension transfers. On the Financial Services Register this would show as 'Limited pension transfer activity'.

Firms that withdrew Advising PTOO between 01/09/2020 and 31/12/2020 - 18

Firms that added PTOO limitation between 01/09/2020 and 31/12/2020 - 241
