The table below depicts the number of mortgage sales and value of loans reported by regulated firms through their product sales data reporting to the FCA.

The data is provided by year from 2016 to 2020, with each year starting on 1 January and ending 31 December, and includes the most recent available data. It excludes business loans and second charge mortgages.

Please note the data may be different from other data published by the FCA on mortgage sales due to resubmissions reported by regulated firms.
