Please see attached in annex A the list of firms in the Temporary Permissions Regime (TPR) as at 19/03/21. Please note that it excludes firms that have applied to cancel their temporary permission(s). These firms formerly passported into the UK and notified us before 31/12/2021 that they wanted to enter TPR.
