Thank you for your email of 3 March 2021, in which you asked for information relating to applications for authorised payment institution (API) licenses.

We have processed your request in line with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) and will answer each point in turn.

1. How many applications for API licenses have been received in 2021 so far?

The FCA has received 11 applications for approval as an API up to 9 March 2021.

- 3. How many API license applications were received in 2020, and of those, how many were approved and how many were refused?

The FCA received 83 applications for approval as an API in 2020. Of these, 27 applications were approved with none being refused.

Out of the applications received in 2020, 15 have been voluntarily withdrawn by the applicants before a decision was reached.
