So it depends what type of business the firm is doing. UK firms that only do business in the UK may be much less directly affected if they're affected at all. However UK firms that do business in the European Economic Area, the EEA, are much more likely to be affected, that's whether they're doing business through a passport or directly through European Legislation. But whatever type of firm you are or whatever type of business you're doing it's important you still check our website because there may still be issues that affect you. For example if you transfer personal data between the UK and the EEA you may be affected and the particular types of firms.
