UK firms should understand the legal basis upon which they do business in or into the EU today. This could include the use of a passport.

Passporting will end if the UK leaves the EU without an implementation period.

Firms should check if they need any additional regulatory permissions to do business in the EU after exit.

This could also include servicing existing customers or existing contracts, so please do check.

You should seek advice from the relevant regulator, in the country you do business in or seek legal advice, where appropriate.
